In preparation for 2025, please note the following logistical details.

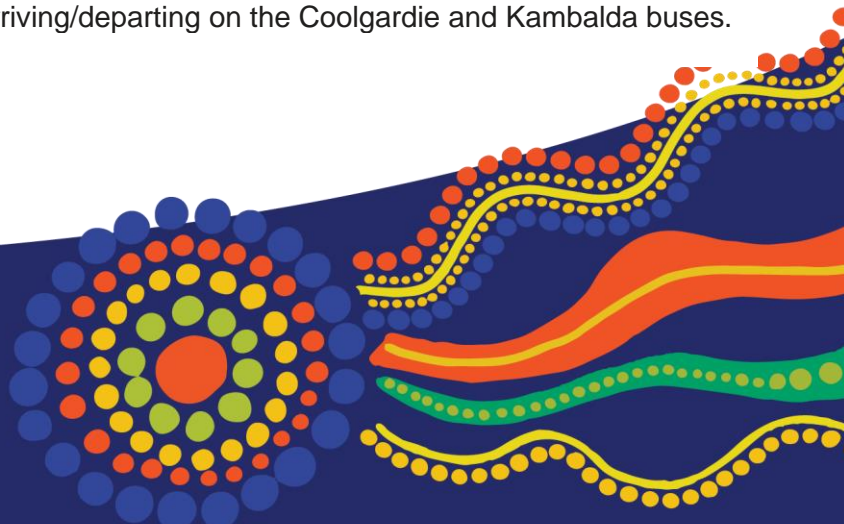
All students

- School term begins on Wednesday 5 February.
- School starts at 8:50am and finishes at 2:50pm
- Calendar items to be aware of:

Year 11 students:

- Students will be based at Middle campus, on Boomerang Crescent
- Students are to be dropped off by parents or arrive after 8:30am. Main access is through the pedestrian gate on Boomerang Crescent.
- Students who arrive on ESC buses will be required to sit on the outside benches until 8:30am. Parents to notify school for any students arriving/departing on the Coolgardie and Kambalda buses
- Work Placement (Thursday) is expected to start in Week 3. Students who are not attending Work Placement will generally be expected to stay home. More information will be provided next year.

Year 12 students:

- Students will be based at our Senior classroom on the TAFE/Eastern Goldfields College campus. This site is an “open campus”, which means that members of the public jointly use the buildings and areas.
- Access to external classroom areas and supervision will begin at 8:30am. A table is available near the class gate for students who arrive earlier.
- Work Placement (Thursday) is expected to start in Week 2. Students who are not attending Work Placement will generally be expected to stay home. More information will be provided next year.
